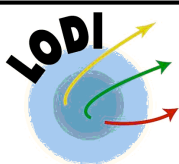

5 FIRE-FIGHTING MEASURES (continued)

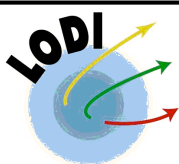

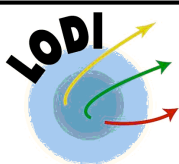
